

Special Consideration

The school will grant special consideration to students who were away from school for a period of time or students who experienced a limitation in their ability to do any school work for a period of time. The following procedure will be followed in considering the granting of special consideration:

- Each case will be considered on an individual basis.
- The QSA, and at times, panel chairs will be contacted when required.
- The student under discussion must still be given the opportunity to meet the mandatory aspects of the syllabus – this will be different for each subject.
- Additional assessments could be provided.
- As soon as the student returns to school or is able to commence study again, an alternative study plan should be discussed to enable the student to meet the suitable requirements of the different subjects.
- All parties (parents, students and Senior School staff) need to agree to and sign off on the alternate study plan prior to approval by the Principal.
- In cases of medical reasons, students must provide evidence of the extent of their illness as soon as possible.
