

Outdoor Classroom Statement

Learning happens in a range of environments. We encourage teachers to use the College grounds, our local area and beyond for learning activities. With our own transport on site we are continually thinking of ways to use real life experiences to explore and consolidate concepts.

To facilitate the smooth integration of moving between different learning environments it is the policy of the College that parents agree to permit their children to participate in our programs wherever they take place at the time of enrolment through the associated documents they sign. Often we notify families of learning programs that involve off-campus locations through verbal, written or electronic means. This is not always the case, for example, we visit the local library for research.

If the event involves any activities that could be dangerous or involves overnight or out of school hour attendance then we will seek direct permission from families. For example, if the children were going camping or horse riding we would seek direct permission.
