

To promote a child safe, friendly and healthy environment we have the following rules:

Entry is restricted to people on legitimate school business. All visitors must report to administration on entry. All parents must report to the Student Services Centre (unless their business is just with Reception then they may go directly there).

*Exception:*

*Parents may enter at normal start and finish times.*

*Major event days, such as sports days and parent interview evenings, may have different arrangements in place.*

During school time, if parents need to pass a message or item onto their children or to the teachers, student services staff will make the arrangements.

Everyone who is given permission to access rooms or grounds must read the child safety statements, sign in and wear appropriate identification badges.

Please remember:

No Smoking, tobacco, alcohol, drug or substance use is permitted on our campus.

No animals are allowed on College campus (Exceptions exist for Show and Tell days and Pet Shows etc: These will be advertised at the time of the exception). Certified guide, hearing and assistance dogs are permitted to enter the campus. People accompanied by a guide, hearing or assistance dog, including trainers, must be able to present their identity card upon request by a staff member. Assistance animals must wear a coat or harness to identify it as an assistance animal.

Appropriate clothing, behaviour and language must be displayed by all people on site.

Please Note:

On the College grounds and at College events parents are not permitted to directly approach College students (other than own children) about issues (eg classroom matters, lunchtime incidents, or at school sporting events) or issue letters or other material. This rule does not refer to the normal conversation between family friends or school friends, for example, organising birthday parties. This rule does prevent parent helpers discussing work with children in the classroom or on field trips.
