

Year 12 Senior Jerseys

Year 12 students may wear a specific cohort Year 12 Senior Jersey.

The following guidelines apply:

- Overall design: Jersey colours and design should be based around the College colours (keeping in the tradition of previous Year 12 jerseys: Whitsunday should be emphasised (WCC is not to be used).
- Individual Names: Slogans or wording should not contradict the Christian ethos of the College and are to be approved by the Dean of Studies.
- Jersey design and style must be approved by the Principal: order with style must have signature of principal on it.
- Students may wear them as alternative additional piece of warmer clothing when required over their school uniform.

By the end of August of the previous year orders need to be finalised (paid for and ordered). To achieve this for next year's Year 12 cohort:

- At the start of Term 3, Year 11 Home Class teacher works with Year 11 cohort to decide on design (preferably just use one from the past that we know we liked) and have the Principal agree in concept.
- Students who wish to purchase select wording and pay the cost in full to reception by 12:00 pm on the last working day in August.
- Wording is checked by Senior School Coordinator.
- Order with style is to be signed by Principal.
- Order is made by Accounts Officer.
- Order is tracked by Accounts officer.
- Jerseys are handed out when they arrive.
