The College is aware that a number of Senior School students drive to school, TAFE or school based apprenticeships either occasionally or on a regular basis. It is important that all members of the school community are aware of the College procedures on this matter. Specifically:

- Enrolled students are permitted to drive on College grounds adhering to road safety rules and speed limits.
- Students are permitted to park on College grounds behind the Administration building, along the fence line only.
- Student must provide a copy of their license, car model and registration details to Administration.
- Students are only permitted to transport other students when parents/carers have agreed to this arrangement prior to travel and a 'Permission to Transport Student Form' has been completed by all parties.
- It is expected that students will drive in a safe, responsible and respectful manner, adhering to road rules. It is expected that passengers will behave in a supportive manner and not distract the driver. Families will be contacted if issues arise.
